Main responsibilities

- Coordinate pre-event set up of furniture, bar, catering and other equipment as required.

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- Delegating roles to Crew members and ensuring that all tasks are completed to a high standard.
- Conducting pre-event briefing with Crew and Skipper before the event starts.
- Welcoming guests & clients on board for their event. Confirming with organiser that all guests are present before the barge departs.
- Delivery of the Health & Safety announcement over the PA for guests if the Skipper is unable to do so.
- Awareness of event schedule and key timings, e.g. caterer arrival, food service, last orders, etc.
- Act as the go-to person for the organiser throughout the event and ensure attentive and friendly service is provided.
- Assist with bar service, food service and glass collection/ replenishment during the event.
- Ensure bar, cabin and bathrooms are clean and presentable for the duration of the cruise.
- · Assist the Skipper in communicating with other canal users, boat safety and fending as instructed.
- Ensure that the end of the hire runs smoothly, guests disembark the barge promptly and safely and that all their belongings have been removed from the venue.
- Work with the Skipper to promote a safe and secure environment for guests and Crew.
- Conflict resolution with customers where required.
- Manage post-event clearing, cleaning and restocking. Ensure all post-event instructions given by the Events Manager are followed.

Salary & Work Pattern

This is a freelance role; you need a NI number for invoicing, and you must be available to work on weekends. You will be responsible for your own National Insurance contributions where applicable.

Our Events Manager will be in touch regularly to share details of upcoming shifts and you may apply for those which suit your schedule. Shifts will be predominantly on weekends and evenings.

The rate of pay for this role is £13.00 per hour plus monthly tip share.
